Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus. The World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared the spread of the Covid-19 disease caused by the coronavirus outbreak as a pandemic.

Nexperia Response

Nexperia facilities

Production in Nexperia's Frontend factories in Europe and the Back-end facility in Guangdong province (China) continue to run normally. Although the loading in our Manchester facility is reduced, it continues to serve the current customer demand.

The government of Malaysia announced to extend the lockdown until May 12. **Within these regulations our factory in Seremban received approval to ramp up back to full operational level, effective starting next week and orderbook pull-ins will be executed in line with this. Given this positive development Nexperia will be able to accept additional upside orders.**

The government in the Philippines announced to extend the lockdown of its capital region until May 15. **The successful execution of our mitigation plans for this scenario allows us to extend capacity already on short notice. We are going to increase output from next week onwards significantly, with the goal to be back at normal production levels by the end of May.**

Despite the extensive actions the extension of the lockdown in the Philippines will result in a limited production capacity from our facility in Cabuyao for the month of May. Nexperia will continue to apply formal allocation principles to fairly distribute available supply to our customers

The Customer Service Teams are continuously updating the orderbook confirmations for our Cabuyao portfolio and will share supply impacts with our customers where needed.

External Suppliers

Nexperia's key suppliers continue to fully support Nexperia for both manufacturing material deliveries and end-customer production.

General

Local response teams remain in place. We are strictly following the global WHO COVID-19 advice. As well as the recommendations of local government and health authorities.

This is an extraordinary situation mandated by government regulations. Nexperia will do its utmost for a continuous supply of goods, but we will not accept any liability for any shortages in delivery or other consequences caused by this force majeure situation.
